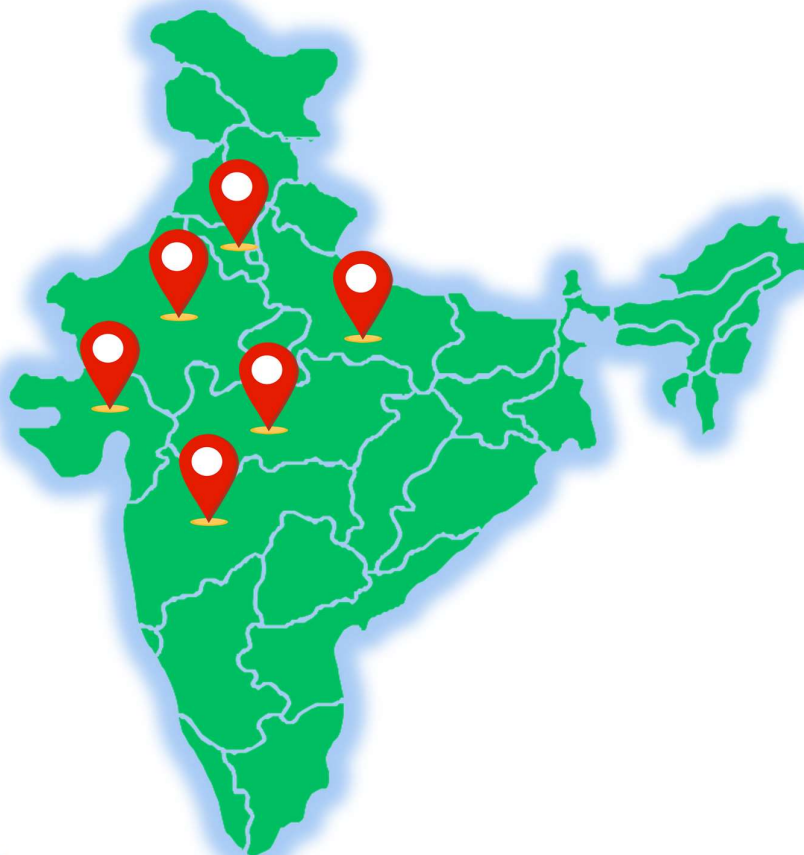

Executive Summary

In the fiscal year 2023-24, **Arpan Seva Sansthan** continued its mission of holistic rural development, making significant strides across multiple sectors and positively impacting thousands of lives across India. Our integrated approach focused on sustainable resource management, climate resilience, improved health and sanitation, enhanced education, women's empowerment, and livelihood development.

Key Achievements



1.  **Natural Resource Management and Climate Action:**
 - ✚ Constructed/ Renovation of **43** water harvesting structures, construction of **20000** cubic meters of Soil Water Conservation Measures and 10 farm ponds.
 - ✚ Installed 8 solar water lifting pumps and repaired **30** wells.
 - ✚ Storage Capacity over **89,450** cubic meters of water.
 - ✚ Reduced carbon emissions by **8 million kg** through ecological restoration efforts.
 - ✚ Planted **4,000 trees** across **20 hectares** of pastureland in Kurabad block, Udaipur, Rajasthan.
2.  **Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH):**
 - ✚ Installed **68 G-filters** benefiting families and government institutions.
 - ✚ Renovated the Mahoji (Bapini) Talab, increasing water storage capacity by **12,960 cubic meters**.

- Set up libraries in **14** government schools.
- Promoted smart classrooms in 10 schools, benefiting over **1,200** students.
- Established **12** model Anganwadi centre's.
- Conducted over **50** training programs on various topics including agriculture, health, and microenterprise development.



6. **Health & Nutrition:**

- Conducted health camps benefiting **748** patients.
- Trained **25** ASHA workers and Anganwadi operators.
- Established kitchen gardens for **575** families across multiple districts



7. **Capacity Building and Community Empowerment:**

- Executed **816** Gram Panchayat level training sessions under Atal Bhujal Yojana, reaching over **41,000** community members.
- Formed and strengthened **324** Water User Associations.
- Conducted extensive awareness programs on water conservation and management.



8. **Partnerships and Collaborations:**

- Implemented projects in collaboration with state governments, central schemes like **MGNREGA**, and **corporate partners**.
- Strengthened partnerships with research institutions like IIT-Jodhpur, MBM University-Jodhpur, MPUAT-Udaipur, CIMAP-Lucknow, CEDSI- Gurugram for technological innovations.

Through these multifaceted initiatives, Arpan Seva Sansthan has continued to empower rural communities, promote sustainable development, and create lasting positive change. Our holistic approach has not only improved immediate living conditions but also laid the foundation for long-term socio-economic growth and environmental sustainability in our target areas.

As we move forward, we remain committed to aligning our efforts with national development goals and global sustainability targets, ensuring that rural communities are at the forefront of India's journey towards inclusive and sustainable development.

Natural Resource Management: Fostering Resilience and Sustainability

Arpan Seva Sansthan continues to lead in implementing nature-based solutions to address the interlinked challenges of climate change, biodiversity loss, and rural livelihood security. Our Natural Resource Management (NRM) initiatives in **2023-24** have focused on ecosystem restoration, climate-smart agriculture, and sustainable water management, aligning closely with India's Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) under the Paris Agreement and the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

Ecosystem Restoration and Climate Mitigation

Our efforts in ecological restoration have yielded significant results in carbon sequestration and biodiversity enhancement:

- I. Reduced carbon emissions by **8 million kg** through strategic afforestation and sustainable land management practices.
- II. **Water Economic Zones (WEZ) project funded by D S Group: 4,000 plantations** across **20 hectares** of degraded pastureland in Kurabad, enhancing ecosystem services and supporting local livelihoods.
- III. **Horticulture WADI - Tribal Development Project:** Established **450 WADIs** (small orchards), integrating agroforestry principles to improve food security and income generation.



Sustainable Water Resource Management

Recognizing water as a critical resource for rural resilience, we have implemented comprehensive water conservation and management strategies:

A. Water Harvesting and Storage

- I. Holistic Rural Development Programme (**HRDP**) in collaboration with **HDFC Bank, Water Economic Zones project funded by D S Group & Environment Protection project funded by C H Robinson**: Constructed/ Renovation of **43** water harvesting structures, construction of **20000** cubic meters of Soil Water Conservation Measures and **10 farm ponds**.
 - Installed **8** solar water lifting pumps and repaired **30 wells**.
 - Total water storage capacity enhanced by **89,450 cubic meters**.
- II. In partnership with **WAPCOS**: Renovated the Mahoji (Bapini) Talab, increasing water storage capacity by, **12,960 cubic meters** benefiting over **15,700** residents in water-stressed regions.



B. Efficient Irrigation Systems



- I. **HRDP-HDFC Bank project:** Installed 8 solar-powered water lifting pumps, promoting clean energy use in agriculture.
- II. **Water Economic Zones project funded by D S Group:** Implemented micro-irrigation systems across 40 hectares in Udaipur and Khandwa, significantly improving water use efficiency.

C. Community-Based Water Management

- I. Rajasthan Water Sector Livelihood Improvement Project (**RWSLIP**).
 - Established and strengthened 324 Water User Associations (WUAs).
 - 1. Empowered communities through participatory water budgeting and management training.

Larsen & Toubro Public Charitable Trust (LTPCT): Installation of Solar Powered Community Lift Irrigation Scheme (CLIS)

LTPCT's mission to improve rural livelihoods led to the installation of solar-powered CLIS in Paraspada and Gavthan villages. These projects aim to support tribal farmers by increasing agricultural productivity through efficient water use in irrigation.

Activities:

- **Community Mobilization and Pre-Implementation:** Engaged community members and conducted technical surveys to finalize site selection and irrigation requirements.
- **Procurement and Installation:** Acquired components, including solar pumps, pipelines, and control valves. Solar panels and pumping systems were installed with necessary accessories and civil work for optimal irrigation distribution.
- **Training and WUA Formation:** Established WUAs-“**Saktiveer**” for Paraspada and “**Sanjeevani**” for Gavthan. These associations manage water distribution, system maintenance, and conflict resolution.
- **Civil and Additional Infrastructure:** Constructed valve chambers and fencing to secure solar equipment and valves, ensuring controlled water flow.

Climate-Smart Agriculture and Sustainable Livelihoods

Our interventions have focused on building agricultural resilience while enhancing productivity and farmer incomes:

Activities:

- **ASTHA Model:** Promoted climate-resilient crop varieties and sustainable farming practices, resulting in a **25-30%** increase in crop yields for **720** farmers.
- **Holistic Rural Development Programme** funded by **HDFC bank** in Rajgarh, District: Introduced **70** farmers to floriculture, diversifying income sources and reducing climate vulnerability.
- **Water Economic Zone project** funded by **D S Group** in Kurabad Block, Udaipur District: Facilitated the adoption of sustainable agricultural practices by **800** farmers, leading to a **50%** increase in production.



Circular Economy Initiatives

Embracing the principles of a circular economy, Arpan Seva Sansthan has launched several initiatives that transform waste into valuable resources, ensuring sustainable agricultural practices and environmental conservation. These initiatives focus on reducing waste, improving soil health, and promoting bio-fertilizers for a greener future.

Arpan Seva Sansthan remains committed to empowering rural communities by significantly enhancing their economic conditions through a comprehensive and holistic approach. Our multifaceted strategy focuses on boosting livelihood opportunities in both on-farm and off-farm sectors, ensuring sustainable growth and development within these communities.

Agricultural Livelihood Enhancement

Sustainable Agriculture Practices

1. ASTHA Model Implementation

- Increased paddy and wheat productivity by 25% and 22% respectively
- Benefited over 720 farmers across multiple districts
- Annual income increase of ₹8,000-10,000 for 200 farmers



2. Water Economic Zone Project (Funded by D S Group)

- Location: Kurabad Block, Udaipur District, Rajasthan
- Introduced sustainable agricultural practices to 800 farmers

क्लास वाल पेंटिंग नए शौचालय निर्माण व पेयजल के लिए वाटर स्टैंड का निर्माण भी कराया है साथ ही बच्चों को खेल सामग्री भी वितरण की है इसके साथ-साथ आंगनवाड़ी में भी वाला पेंटिंग व खेल और अध्ययन सामग्री का वितरण भी किया है इसके

अलावा किसानों को उन्नत किस्म का बीज उपलब्ध करवा के खेती में नवाचार करवाने की तरफ भी काम किया है जैविक की खेती की तरफ किसानों को अग्रसर किए यहाँ पर बहुत स्तरीय खेती कराकर 4 को विभिन्न प्रकार की सब्जियों के बाच वितरण कर सब्जी की खेती कराई है इसके साथ ही फलदार पौधे भी लगवाए गए हैं जिससे किसानों की आमदनी बढ़ेगी भूमिहीन परिवारों को शुद्ध सब्जी मिले इसके लिए किचन गार्डन का बीज भी वितरण किया गया है महिलाओं को धूआ रहित उन्नत चूल्हा दिया गया है अब महिलाओं के आजीविका बढ़ाने के लिए मुर्गी पालन की तरफ भी अग्रसर किया गया है कौशल विकास के प्रशिक्षण भी कराए गए हैं साथ ही स्वयं सहायता समूह को आर्थिक सहायता उपलब्ध करवा कर उनके रोजगार को बढ़ावा देने का कार्य भी किया है इस तरह के अनेक कार्य यहां पर अपना सेवा संस्थान द्वारा किया जा रहा है जिससे ग्रामीण विकास को चार चांद लग रहे हैं इस बार संस्थान को गणतंत्र दिवस के उपलक्ष पर प्रशंसा पत्र देकर प्रशासन द्वारा सम्मानित भी किया गया है
